**Secondary Report Cards** –Interim Report cards will be sent home on Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup>. Mid-term report cards will be sent home on May 1<sup>st</sup>.

**Secondary Parent/Teacher Interviews** – Parents can book appointments for interviews online. Interviews will take place on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Instructions will be sent home with interim report cards on March 25<sup>th</sup> or they can be found on the school website. Interviews will take place from 4-6pm. Email addresses for staff can be found on the school website if parents need to reach out to a teacher at any time.

**Secondary Final Exams** – Final exams are scheduled for Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> – Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. There will be one PD Day at the end of the school year on June 26<sup>th</sup>. Parents are to refrain from booking family vacations on, around, or leading up to this time period. Many semester end final culminating tasks/activities as well as the final exam take place during this time which counts as 30% of the term work for the student.

**Grade 6 Parent Information Night** – On May 13<sup>th</sup>, SDSS will host a parent information night for families who will be transitioning to our school next year as they have a child entering grade 7.

**Transition Visits** – Our learning resource teachers are in the process of scheduling transition meetings with staff and families of students who will be transitioning to secondary or grade 7. Parents are encouraged to reach out if they have questions.

**Literacy** – The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test is scheduled to be written on March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020. However, there are questions about if schools will proceed given current sanctions. Information will be shared with parents as it is available. It is our plan to have timetables available for students just prior to exams in June.
